Graffiti Art at The Base

The Base, a community building in the Salts Recreation Ground Seaford, has been rejuvenated thanks to young people in Seaford and the Community Payback Scheme. Louisa Young (Anti-Social Behaviour Co-ordinator) and Ben King (Seaford Town Council) organised community payback to give the centre a spruce up by re painting the inside and outside of the building. Following the success of last year's graffiti project at the skate park in The Salts, Sam Whittaker (East Sussex Youth Development Service) set up a further project for young people to create a graffiti arts mural in the newly freshened Base. The walls now feature a wide range of sports and music images to give The Base a new lease of life. The building is currently used by the young people of Seaford who attend band nights and drop in sessions run by the Youth Development Service, and it is hoped that the new look will encourage many more users.
