Re-advertisement – Amended Description

The Old House Depository Claremont Road

Construction of 35 dwellings (26 x open-market and nine x affordable) accessed from Claremont Road and Station Approach with associated parking and hard and soft landscaping. Amended drawings include a reduction in the no. of 4 bed houses and an increase in the no. of 2 and 3 bed houses together with elevational changes to the materials and design.

Objection on grounds of overdevelopment, highway concerns in respect of additional traffic on Claremont Road, insufficient affordable housing, and that it goes against Seaford Town Council policy of retaining commercial property from being converted to residential.

However, if this application is approved then we suggest, S106

agreement is drawn up for consideration of additional health facilities as existing are beyond capacity, road improvements to the roundabout on Station Approach & access to the A259 at Claremont Road, additional places at local schools, contribution to recreational open spaces (not just play facilities) and contribution to access to local public transport improvements. The Salts which is in close proximity.

Former Central Garage Sutton Park Road

LW/14/0150

Planning Application - Demolition of the former garage building and construction of a five storey building comprising 38 retirement apartments, basement car park, access and landscaping for PegasusLife.

Eric Woodward Requested to the committee that this proposal be refused on grounds of Seaford Town is in need of affordable housing to the younger generation. The site could be used for younger people to meet in a safe environment rather than loitering round Seaford Town in the evenings.

Objection on grounds of going against Seaford Town Policy to turn a commercial property into residential, overdevelopment of the site, significant overshadowing, parking issue in Stafford Road and out of keeping with local area, and evidence of need for additional retirement properties not demonstrated. Seaford Town Council would prefer a development for mixed use including family and affordable homes,

However, if this application was to be approved then we suggest S106 agreement is drawn up for consideration to highways improvements in Broad Street, Warwick and Avondale Roads, contribution to additional health facilities, contribution towards improvement of open spaces in the town, not just play area provision.
