being held by Lewes District Council

1. To nominate three Members of the Committee to attend the training session on 10 July 2013.

1. Information

- 1.1 Lewes District Council is holding a planning training session on Wednesday, 10 July 2013 at 6.30 pm at Council Chamber, Town Hall, Lewes.
- 1.2 It is designed to keep members up to date with Government reforms to the planning system over recent months, and to explain the likely impact at the local level.
- 1.3 The session will cover
 - (a) Changes to permitted development rights and the impact on planning issues in Lewes District: the Government have relaxed planning regulations, so a wider range of developments can now be carried out without planning permission. The changes will be explained and the impact on our area discussed.
 - Planning Policy Update: Progress on the Lewes District Local Plan Core Strategy; the "Duty to Co-operate" and how it is working in Sussex; and a progress report on other areas of planning policy work including the Site Allocations/Development Management document and the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Charging Schedule.



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- **1.4** Officers from the South Downs National Park Authority will also be present at the training session.
- 1.5 The session will last for about two hours, ending at 8.30 pm at least.
- 1.6 They are offering up to three places for each Town/Parish Council.
