Street and West Street to facilitate the French Market.

1. Information

- 1.1 A notice has been submitted by Mr Dave Argent for Seaford Chamber of Commerce requesting that part of Church Street and West Street be closed on 14 September 2012 to facilitate the French Market. The event begins at 06.00.
- 1.2 Church Street will be closed from the junction of Place Lane to South Street. West Street will be closed from Church Street to the rear entrance to 37 Church Street. The closure will be in effect between 06.00 and 19.00 on that day. A map detailing the area to be closed is attached as appendix A.
- 1.3 The proposal has been discussed with the Police.
- 1.4 Lewes DC have requested the Council pass on any general observations it might have upon the notice and to advise whether or not it considers an Order under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 be made. They would like a response by 24 July 2012.



To inform the Committee of a consultation concerning

proposed waiting restrictions at Junction Belgrave Road and

Wilkinson Way Seaford.

Recommendations

You are recommended:

1. To consider a response to the consultation concerning proposed waiting restrictions

1. Information

- 1.1 We have received a consultation from ESCC concerning proposed waiting restrictions on Belgrave Road and Wilkinson Way
- 1.2 As part of ESCC planning obligations (connected to planning application LW/3069/CC Seaford CP School) new waiting restrictions have been put forward to improve the junction visibility and road safety on Wilkinson Way at its junction with Belgrave Road.
- 1.3 This will involve placing double yellow lines for ten metres on either side of Wilkinson Way at the junction and for ten metres on Belgrave Road on either side of the junction.
- 1.4 It is also proposed to make the existing school keep clear markings outside the Seaford CP School in Wilkinson Way mandatory to make them enforceable in law.
- **1.5** ESCC has requested a response by 26 July 2012.
