



## Seaford Town Council

### To the Members of the Planning and Highways Committee

Under current guidelines from government, the Council is not able to hold public meetings in its usual manner. As a result and in order to ensure the town continues to be represented with relevant planning applications submitted, the members of the Council's Planning and Highways Committee are therefore being asked to consider the following planning applications by email before submitting a response to Lewes District Council, as the local planning authority.

To confirm, the next scheduled meeting of the Planning and Highways Committee on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> April has been cancelled due to the coronavirus restrictions. If the meeting had gone ahead the following applications would have been discussed:-

**LW/20/0113 - 98 SUTTON ROAD** - Conversion of integral garage to additional living accommodation (deferred from 12th March meeting)

**LW/20/0174 - 27 ROOKERY WAY** - Erection of front PVC u porch with access steps

**LW/19/0835 - 58 TUDOR CLOSE** - Double storey side extension

**LW/20/0136 - 27 DEAL AVENUE** - Demolition of existing rear conservatory and replacement with a single storey rear extension. Construction of detached garage and hardstanding. Internal alterations.
