# **Town Meeting**

Minutes of the Town Meeting of the Town Council held at Seaford Baptist Church, Belgrave Road, Seaford, on Tuesday 30 April 2013 at 7.00 pm.

# 1. Welcome and Introductions by the Mayor

The Mayor welcomed the attendees and outlined the format of the evening.

#### 2. Minutes

The minutes of the Annual Town Meeting held 1 May 2013, were agreed by the meeting and signed by the Mayor.

## 3. Seaford Town Council Annual Report 2012/13

Councillor Ian White, Leader of Seaford Town Council, introduced the Annual Report. He also thanked the Councillors, especially Mark Brown and the Staff of Seaford Town Council. The Mayor invited questions and comments from the public in relation to the Annual Report.

### 4. Reports from recipients of large grants

Verbal reports were given by representatives of recipients of large grants awarded by Seaford Town Council 2012-13 from the Citizens Advice Bureau, Seaford Rugby Club, Dial-a-Ride, Seaford Community Partnership and Seaford Youth Forum.

# 5. Reports by the Mayor's Charities and the Mayor's Community Awards

Janet White from St James' Trust thanked the Mayor for choosing St James' Trust as one of chosen charities. They have spent £60,000 in legal fees, but the clubhouse is now up to date with new double glazing. They have had an electric bill of £3,500 due to an ancient heater still in place at the clubhouse. They are currently fundraising for a community centre.

The Mayor presented a £1,791 cheque to Janet White on behalf of St James' Trust.
