## Our Impact During Covid-19

- ❖ Delivered over 400 unique food shopping and prescription medicines orders to local vulnerable people shielding in Lewes & Wealden Districts, including many in Seaford
- ❖ Opened up our members only Dial-a-Ride service to key workers who needed to travel
- ❖ Provided free weekly transport for Seahaven Storehouse to move bulk food orders from Lewes to their Seaford base
