# *Martello Tower Entertainments Area*

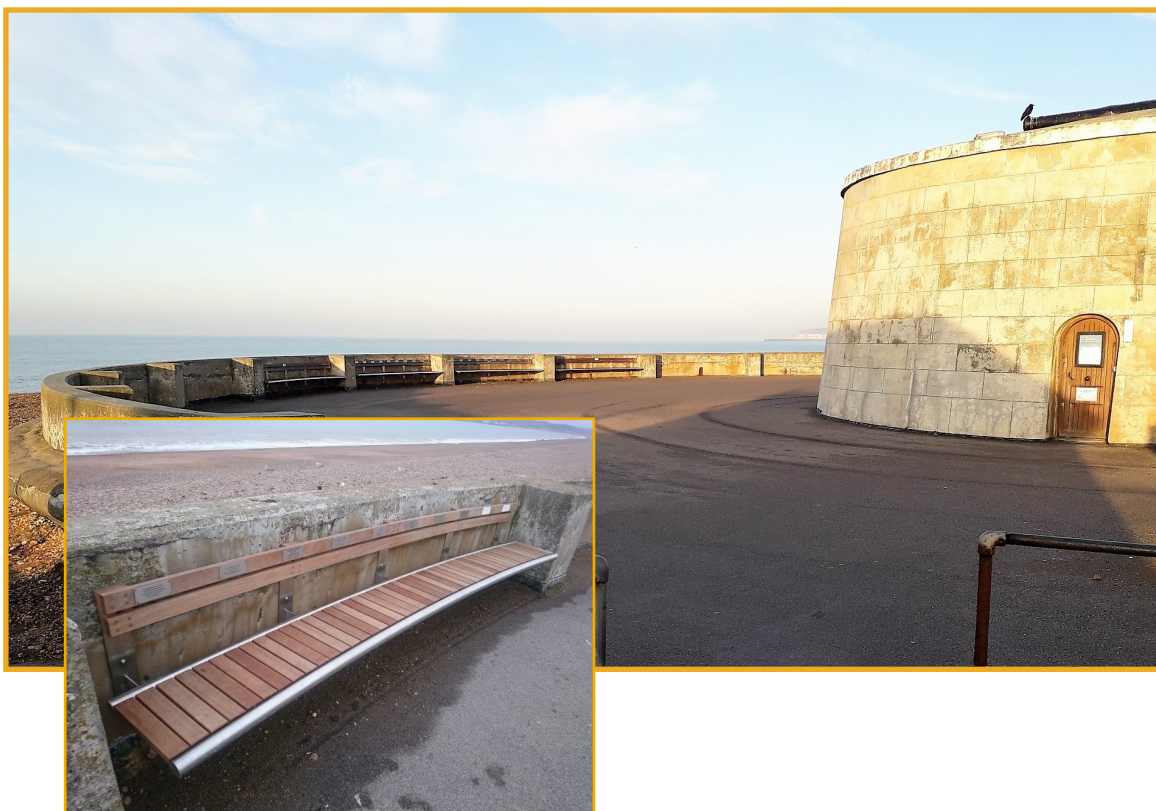
Work on this significant project is progressing. The Martello Tower, which houses the popular Seaford Museum, is a well-loved feature of the town. The museum receives over 7,000 visitors each year and the adjacent café, with seating on the beach, means that this area of the seafront receives one of the highest footfalls in the town.

So far four memorial seats have been installed on the inside of the outer wall of the Martello Tower in the form of curved benches between the buttresses. The chosen design consists of stainless steel tubing to form the structural parts of the seating, with hardwood slats and seat backs. Memorial plaques have been fitted to the seat backs.

Donations will be put towards a public performance area adjacent to the Martello Tower for use by local musicians and performing artists, a power supply for the performers to use, signage and new litter bins. It is anticipated that this area, with wonderful views of Seaford Head, will become a social hub and focal point in the town.

## *Donation:*

The all-inclusive donation including supply, delivery, installation, an individual plaque (one of ten above each seat) and ongoing maintenance, to be carried out by the Council when required, is £800.



# *Benches*

The locations which are currently available for benches are listed below. The model used is an attractive, high-quality and reasonably maintenance-free design, which is capable of withstanding winter weather conditions. The back support can be engraved.

The Salts Recreation Ground

Small Crouch Garden

Seaford Head Golf Course (waiting list in operation)

## *Donation:*

The standard donation including supply, delivery, installation and engraving up to 60 characters is £1,300. Extra installation charges may occur depending on location.



We regret that it is no longer possible to donate a bench to be located on the Seaford Head Nature Reserve overlooking the Seven Sisters as this land is managed by the Sussex Wildlife Trust who wish to keep it as natural as possible.

Bench locations along the promenade are now also full, although the Martello Tower Entertainments Area does offer an excellent alternative.

## *The View*

Simple, slatted benches, which can be positioned on the terrace at The View at Seaford Head Golf Course to take full advantage of the wonderful panorama, can be offered as an alternative. Please note that these benches would not be fixed and would have a memorial plaque. There is currently availability for 4 benches.

### *Donation:*

The all-inclusive donation including supply, delivery and a plaque is £600.



The normal maintenance of all benches will be carried out by the Council, when required, for a guaranteed maximum of 15 years.

# *Picnic Tables*

The donation of a picnic table provides a lovely means to create a lasting memorial to be enjoyed by residents and visitors to Seaford. The picnic area at South Hill Barn is now full, however donations would very much be appreciated for the picnic space at The Salts and adjacent to the sunny patio at The View.

The tables are hand-made in durable wood with a lifespan of over 15 years. A stainless steel memorial plaque can be fixed to the surface.

Locations currently available are:

Salts Recreation Ground	4 tables
The View at Seaford Head	4 tables
Crouch playground	2 tables

The all-inclusive donation including supply, delivery, installation and a plaque is £1,300.



## *Parks & Recreation Areas*

Donations and sponsorships to improve the facilities in Seaford's parks and recreational areas are always well received, particularly if they can be enjoyed by children with disabilities. Perhaps a fitting memorial for a young family member or a sponsorship opportunity for a local business.

### *Babel Drum*

A babel drum is a fascinating instrument for children to make music together and is maintenance free. It is tuned to replicate the unmistakable sound of steel pans. A wide range of tones can be created through experimenting with different playing techniques. A dedication can be added by means of a memorial plaque, or a sponsorship sign installed. Four would be welcomed at The Salts Recreation Ground.



#### *Donation:*

£1,500 each drum

### *Telescope*

A telescope would be a wonderful addition to the promenade, Splash Point or at High & Over and could be accompanied by a dedication or sponsorship plaque.

#### *Donation:*

2 people donating £1,000 each

4 people donating £500 each



# Public Noticeboards

Public noticeboards play an important role in our community, not only for keeping residents aware of up-to-date information from the Council, but also as a valuable resource for local organisations who can freely publicise their meetings and events. The name of a sponsor can be added to each available board by the addition of an engraving or plaque. The Council will maintain each noticeboard for at least 10 years.

New noticeboards having recently been installed at South Hill Barn, The Buckle Car Park Blatchington Pond, and at the junction of Southdown Road and Chyngton Road.

Future locations will include Walmer Road shop/post office, East Street. Broad Street, the station, the library, the Martello Kiosk, Frankie's Beach Café and Princess Drive shops.

## Entrance signs

The Council would also welcome donations to allow the installation of entrance signs to our parks and open spaces, giving clearer information to anyone using the facility. Signs could be sponsored at the following locations:

Salts Recreation Ground	4 signs
Crouch Gardens	2 signs
Martello Fields	2 signs

## Donation:

The all-inclusive donation to sponsor a noticeboard or park entrance sign is £1,500.





## *Heritage Trail & Exercise Path Boards*

The Heritage Trail Board provides excellent information for visitors to the town, guiding them around Seaford's historic sites, while the Exercise Path Board encourages activity for all abilities with a one or four-mile walking route taking in our beautiful seafront. The boards can be found at several locations and are in need of refurbishment.

\*This option is currently not available while information on the boards is being updated.

### *Donation:*

A donation of £500 will enable a board to be refurbished and the name of the sponsor to be added.



## Commemorative Benches



The Council would like to add two more commemorative benches at the War Memorial on the main A259 road. Each bench can have a small plaque affixed to it, allowing for 45 words.
