



## Information Pack for the Seaford Rotary Queen's Jubilee Competition 2022

### Introduction and Aims

The competition is being organised by Seaford Rotary. It aims to engage young people in an exercise which allows them to write imaginatively and creatively.

### Who can take part?

This competition is open to Primary School children who live at an address with a BN25 postcode.

### Competition Guidelines:

**Task** To write a letter of up to one hundred words to the Queen congratulating her on reaching her Platinum Jubilee.

### Judging

Judges with appropriate skills will be appointed by the organisers. They will consider creativity and originality, legibility and neatness in reaching their decision. The judges will not discuss marks and their decision is final.

### How to Enter

Entries will only be accepted accompanied by the official Entry Form which may be downloaded from the Seaford Rotary website [www.seafordrotary.org.uk](http://www.seafordrotary.org.uk). Entries must be clearly marked with the child's name. There is no charge to enter. The closing date for entries is Friday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2022 and entries can be delivered to Seaford Tourist information Centre, 37 Church Street, Seaford, BN25 1HG.

**Prizes.** Suitable prizes will be awarded by Seaford Rotary.
