C19/06/26 Local Government Reorganisation – Consultation Response June 2026

Full Council considered report 21/26 seeking agreement of the Town Council's response to the modified Local Government Reorganisation proposals.

Members requested that comments be included in the response in relation to: the financial burden of the proposals; the divisiveness of the proposals; clarity of the rejection of proposals by the public consultees; the risks of undermining public trust in the democratic process of local government by ignoring the initial public consultation opinions and data, and; concerns regarding the impact of the proposals on implementation timescales, in particular relation to the time required to needlessly disaggregate services and carve up sub-wards.

C19.2 It was **RESOLVED** to **DELEGATE** power to the Town Clerk to submit the response, as agreed in the meeting, as the formal response on behalf of Seaford Town Council.
